


## WHAT WILL CHURCH LOOK LIKE?

### Introduction

### What should I expect?<sup>1</sup>

#### Social Distancing



2 metres between individuals or household groups



#### Face Coverings



Everyone must wear a suitable face covering  
*(exclusions apply)*



#### Avoid Physical Contact



Sorry - no handshakes or hugs!




#### Handwashing or Sanitiser




Please wash or sanitise hands on arrival and on leaving the church



#### Remain Seated



Please remain comfortably seated for the duration of the service
