Social Distancing



2 metres between individuals or household groups



Face Coverings

(exclusions apply)



Avoid Physical Contact



Sorry - no handshakes or hugs!



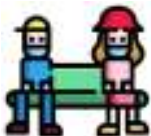
Handwashing or Sanitiser



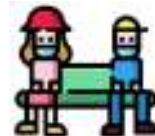
Please wash or sanitise hands on arrival and on leaving the church



Remain Seated



Please remain comfortably seated for the duration of the service

Please, No Singing



Singing (and speaking in a raised voice) are discouraged because of the increased risk of airborne contamination



No Refreshments will be served



We are unable to serve refreshments and the kitchen will be closed.
